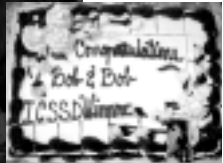

UASC Members Receive AWARDS!

Two members of the Underwater Archaeological Society of Chicago were honored with awards recently by the Illinois Council of Skin and Scuba Diving, while a third became the very first recipient of the brand new award named "The Underwater Archaeological Society of Chicago Award."



At the annual ICSSD "Presidents Night," held on October 11, 2008, **Bob Gadbois** received the ICSSD's 2008 "Humanitarian of the Year" Award (*at left*) for all the work he has done for UASC, ICSSD, and other groups for years. **Bob Rushman**, who joined the UASC in February, 2008, enthusiastically jumped in head first and volunteered to organize the massive *Buccaneer* clean-up, which basically took all summer and fall. For this, he became ICSSD's 2008 "Diver of the Year." He gets to display the huge trophy (*at left*) for a year, plus he received a smaller one which he can keep. UASC Shipwreck Report

The formal UASC report on the *Material Service*, a modern and uniquely designed motorized barge lost just off the mouth of the Calumet River on July 29, 1936, with the tragic loss of 15 of the 22 men on board, will be published in 2009, the first UASC wreck report in 14 years.

The UASC conducts shipwreck site surveys which employ field drawings, underwater photography and videotape. Field survey work is augmented by academic historical research. The Society attempts

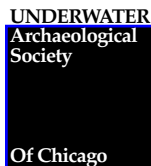
to preserve sites by studying the effects of natural and biological forces as well as the impact of human activity on shipwrecks. It advocates responsible use of submerged cultural resources.
