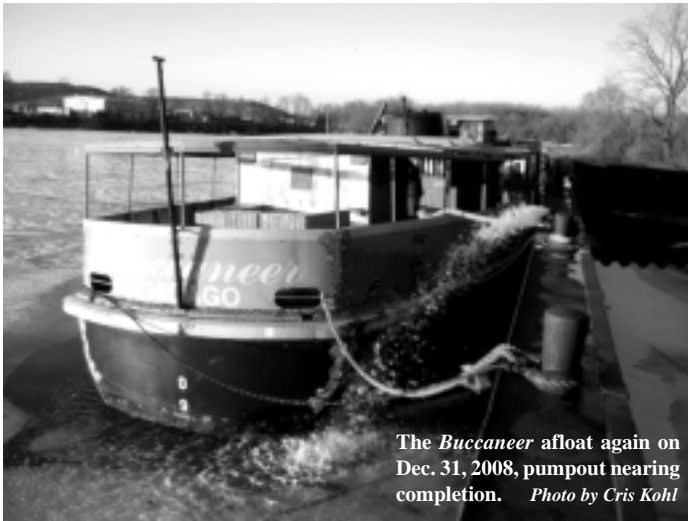

Buccaneer Sinks at Dock!

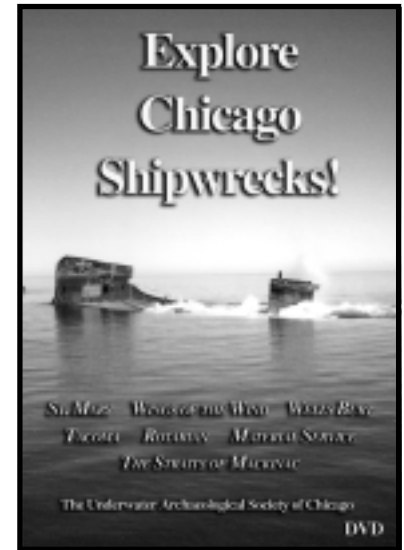


The *Buccaneer* afloat again on Dec. 31, 2008, pumpout nearing completion. Photo by Cris Kohl

The historic former Coast Guard/Chicago excursion vessel last named the *Buccaneer* sank at its dock on Dec. 31, 2008, after ice punctured the steel hull at the bow. **Hank Fiene** and **Keith Pearson** quickly arrived at the scene, pumped the water out, and patched the leak. Plans continue for the 2009 sinking of this vessel off Chicago as a new dive site.

Our UASC meetings (dates for 2009 are given at left) are held at the **Helix Building**, 310 S. Racine Ave., at Jackson Blvd., in Chicago, on the last Wednesday of every month (2nd last in November), beginning at 6:30 PM until about 9 PM. There is free parking available in the Helix parking lots, the main lot being on the west side of the building, and the other one located across the street to the north of the main lot. Meetings are held on either the 6th floor or the 8th floor -- an elevator is available and location signs are posted at the Helix entranceway. We discuss shipwrecks off Chicago and UASC projects in progress, plus we have exciting guest speakers. *Join us! The public is welcome!*

UASC: A Brief Review of 2008

The Underwater Archaeological Society of Chicago had an active 2008, as lively above the water line as below it. The following information relates the activities at each meeting, as well as beyond:

January, 2008: Guest speaker Maritime Historian **Fred Neuschel** talked about Lake Michigan lumber shipping. New President **Joan Forsberg** unveiled plans for the year.

February, 2008: Past President **Cris Kohl** presented "Tall Ships Chicago: Then and Now," a 2004 UASC presentation. (Co-presenter, Past President **Jim Jarecki**, was ill.) Cris received the OW-U Achievement Award -- the first of five UASC members to receive major awards this year! UASC had a booth at OW-U and the Chicago Maritime Fest.

March, 2008: Guest speaker and UASC member **Brendon Baillo** talked about the long-lost **Griffon**, the first ship on the upper Great Lakes, and he displayed portions of his archival Great Lakes collection.

April, 2008: UASC member **Larry Boucha** presented early underwater video of the **Wells Burt** wreck off Chicago, plus footage of the deep Lake Superior wreck of the **Gunilda**. Nine UASC divers explore Bonne Terre Mine in Missouri.

May, 2008: Guest Speaker **Jim Gentile**, local dive boat charter captain, related plans to clean up and sink the historical ship, the **Buccaneer**, off Chicago, and suggested UASC could be involved with the clean-up for a few weekends.

June, 2008: Guest speaker and UASC member **Keith Pearson** showed two UASC presentations from the early 1990's, about the **St. Mary** and the **Rotarian**, both Chicago shipwrecks. **Cris Kohl** talked about the oldest wreck discovered to date in the Great Lakes (the **Ontario**, lost in 1780, found in May, 2008, in about 400 feet of Lake Ontario water). 20 UASC members and guests spent three days touring the land and diving the wrecks at **Door County, WI**.

July, 2008: Guest speaker **Patrick Hammer**, owner of two dive shops and the Our World--Underwater Show, spoke about the challenges of scuttling a large ship to create a new dive site (he scuttled **The Straits of Mackinac** in 2003). UASC members, under **Bob Rushman**, began the clean-up of the **Buccaneer**. The Tim Early Foundation (Pat Hammer) offered to match **Buccaneer** donations to \$1,000.00 max. **Hank Fiene** took UASC u/w photographers to the **Material Service** wreck.

August, 2008: Guest speaker **Doug Gossage**, dive shop owner and shipwreck hunter, showed and explained the use of sidescan sonar. More work on the **Buccaneer** clean-up.

September, 2008: Guest speaker **Capt. Dale Bennett**, a charter boat operator, shared many of his Lake Michigan shipwreck diving experiences. UASC member **Brendon Baillo** received one of the two major awards given annually by the Association for Great Lakes Maritime History. More weekend work on the **Buccaneer** clean-up. UASC's first shipwreck DVD project began, coordinated by **Ruth Loftus**.

October, 2008: Milwaukee Maritime Historian/Author **Art Chavez** talked about railroad car ferries on Lake Michigan, particularly the wreck of the **Milwaukee**. UASC members **Bob Rushman** and **Bob Gadbois** received, respectively, the "2008 Diver of the Year Award" and the "2008 Humanitarian Award" from the Illinois Skin and Scuba Diving Council.

November, 2008: Maritime Historians/Authors/Underwater Videographers **Jim and Pat Stayer** did a presentation on the deep Lake Huron wreck of the schooner **Dunderberg**, lost in 1868. UASC Past President **Jim Jarecki** became the first recipient of the annual "UASC Award." *Photos by Cris Kohl*

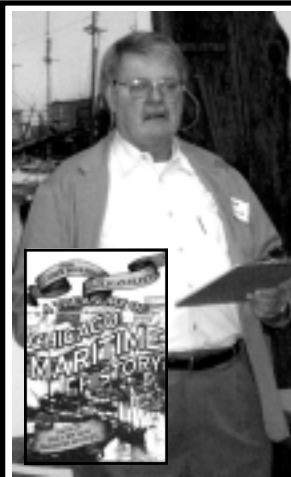

The UASC conducts shipwreck site surveys which employ field drawings, underwater photography and videotape. Field survey work is augmented by academic historical research. The Society attempts

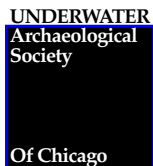
to preserve sites by studying the effects of natural and biological forces as well as the impact of human activity on shipwrecks. It advocates responsible use of submerged cultural resources.
